

1. New Regulatory Framework in Nursing Home Care

6 June; 10 July; 16 September

On March 31st, 2025, the Health Act 2007 (Care and Welfare of Residents in Designated Centres for Older People) (Amendment) Regulations 2025 (S.I. No. 1 of 2025) came into effect with amending regulations related to nursing homes in Ireland, including visiting, infection control, residents' rights, and governance, to strengthen current provisions within organisations. In addition, there is an introduction of NIMS within the private sector linkages to patient safety Act 2023 and notifiable events. **This programme will outline the changes to regulations that affect residential care centres and identify key action plans needed.**

2. Safeguarding Thematic Inspections Preparation

This programme will outline all core aspects of Thematic analysis of safeguarding inspections to date in line with 6 core principles of Empowerment, Proportionality, Accountability, Rights-based approach, Partnership and Prevention in safeguarding. In addition, we will review new HIQA thematic Inspection changes with overview and actions required. Key tips for the safeguarding plan within same and will focus on new inspection document. Core areas addressed to date are medication focused, policy, training, induction, rights and positive risk taking and capacity and capability requirements.

3. Care Planning: Safeguarding resident rights thematic focus

This programme outlines safeguarding / resident rights care planning - the key principles of this care planning process and linkages of assessments regarding consent, finances, self-administration, positive risk taking, choice, FREDa and care planning interventions and evaluations. The course will identify and particular focus on care plan required under safeguarding thematic inspection, with core area in proportionality, risk, empowerment focused upon the identified needs, concerns, wishes of residents.

4. Safeguarding and Risk Management

18 June; 25 September

This programme outlines the key principles of risk management and linkages of risk assessments that can support the team in meeting safeguarding thematic inspections. As risk and proportionality is a key area of safeguarding requests regarding how to write risk overview, calculation of risk, application of risk assessments are explored. The course will identify and place particular focus risk assessments and risk under safeguarding thematic inspection, with core area in proportionality, risk, empowerment focused upon the identified needs, concerns, wishes of residents.
