

POSITION: Clinical Research Nurse (Cardiology)

Position Summary: We are seeking to recruit a cardiology nurse as part of our Clinical Research Unit in St. Michael's Hospital, Dun Laoghaire. This position will involve clinical care of patients across the spectrum of heart failure as part of a multidisciplinary team and will also focus on research and health services delivery. The candidate should be able to work as part of a team, demonstrate good organisation/planning skills and excellent written, verbal communication skills. Research projects include investigator led, academic and industry sponsored studies in the cardiology therapeutic area.

Responsibilities will include:

- Work within the standard operating procedures and research protocols in accordance with GCP
- Drive on-going clinical research projects through participant recruitment and follow-up, identifying problems early and regular feedback with Principal Investigator and research team
- Ensure all assigned studies are completed to the highest standards in accordance with ICH-GCP, HPRA/EU Directive requirements
- Clinical management of patients in the heart failure unit (outside of the clinical trial setting).
