Thank you for forwarding the correspondence from the Public Service Pay Commission, setting out its timeframe for reporting on Phase 1.

The INMO and IMO request that you correspond with the Public Service Pay Commission seeking confirmation that the Report, on completion in mid-August, will issue to Government, the Public Services Committee and the related parties (IMO and INMO) at the same time.
